Marlon Ernest Douthit was born in Fairbanks, AK to home missionaries building a church there. They moved back to Arkansas when Marlon was 18 months old, where Marlon's father was a bi-vocational pastor, Gospel singer and songwriter, and evangelist, so Marlon grew up around pure country and southern Gospel music in those little country churches in the hills of Arkansas. He started singing in church when he was nine years old. There was always a piano in the Douthit home where the family would often gather to sing. Gospel music was a regular part of life at home for Marlon.

Marlon has been part of four previous recordings including a quartet, a duet, and a solo album. As of January 13, 2020, his fifth recording project, "The Sun's Coming Up", has been released.
